

CODE OF CONDUCT & MEMBER PROTECTION POLICY

All members including players, volunteers, and family members must adhere to the following code of conduct and member protection policies.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Two Wells Football & Netball Sporting Club Inc. is a community-based organisation dedicated to providing inclusive and engaging programs through support and training for aspiring athletes.

Participation in the organisation's programme is subject to the observance of the organisations rules and procedures. The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited. Any participant or staff member who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and not including removal from the program.

1. Failing to co-operate with the committee and their policy's and procedures.
2. Actual or threatened violence towards to fellow participants, staff members or volunteers
3. Verbal, physical or visual harassment to other participants, staff members or volunteers
4. Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
5. Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participants, staff members or volunteers.
6. Discourtesy or rudeness to fellow participants, staff members or volunteers
7. Abusive language towards participants, staff members or volunteers.
8. Possession, use or dealing of illegal drugs at Two Wells Football & Netball Sporting Club Inc. property.
9. Bringing onto Two Wells Football & Netball Sporting Club Inc. property dangerous or unauthorised materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar material.

Players Code of Conduct On Field

1. Play by the rules of the game at all times.
2. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Its performance will benefit and so will you.
3. Be a good sportsperson. Recognise and appreciate good play and players whether it's your team or the opposition.
4. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach and ask them to address the issues through the appropriate channels.
5. Do not be distracted by umpiring decisions, get on with the game.
6. Control your temper. Do not verbally abuse officials, other players or spectators, or unnecessarily provoke others. Initiating violence is neither acceptable nor permitted and will not be tolerated.
7. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, spitting etc.
8. Do not vilify other players, especially in relation to their sex, race, culture or appearance.
9. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
10. Co-operate with your coach, team-mates and opponents.
11. Play for the fun of it, and not just to please parents and coaches.
12. Any player that does not abide by the code of conduct will be removed from the playing arena and told what they have done wrong and the coach will then sit them out of the game for a suitable time to fit the misdemeanour.
